A liturgical task force, appointed by the bishop, has begun its work to collect and/or create liturgies that may then be submitted to the Interim body of General Convention, who is overseeing the implementation of Resolution A068, regarding the development of liturgies to supplement the 1979 Prayer Book.

Your bishops are supporting this work and would like anyone who may have worked on creating such liturgies to <u>reach out to the Rev. Dr. Lauren Winner</u>, as Chair of this task force and/or to respond to any member of the task force who may contact you as we try to compile a collection of these innovative liturgical forms.

Please know that if they have been used without the bishop's express permission, we will not be seeking any kind of disciplinary action. Our aim is to get an accurate picture of what is being developed here in North Carolina at the grassroots level so we can do our part in support of this intentional liturgical exploration and development by The Episcopal Church.
